Action Text: A MOTION was made by Council Member Naylor and seconded by Council Member Delgado to Adopt Resolutions appointing attorneys Jonathan Farris and Carol Jones as temporary municipal court judges for the City of Hattiesburg, effective October 1, 2012.

Council member Delgado clarified, as an amendment to the Motion, that the period of the appointment is for 15 days.

An amended MOTION was made by Council Member Naylor and seconded by Council Member Delgado to Adopt Resolutions appointing attorneys Jonathan Farris and Carol Jones as temporary municipal court judges for the City of Hattiesburg, effective October 1, 2012 through October 16, 2012.

Following discussion, the Motion received the affirmative vote of the Council as follows:

Council Vice President Ware stated that Council members Bradley and Carroll support these two individuals. He thanked Ms. Jones and Mr. Farris for stepping in as temporary judges and said [their appointment] will assure that the court remains up and running for the next two weeks, and will allow Council members time to look at changes the Mayor has proposed and others that Council members are considering. He said Council members will work hard in the next two weeks to put a system in place that will function more effectively and with integrity and confidence.

Council member Delgado stated that the two-week period will give Council members the opportunity to work diligently to come up with a plan that will work for Hattiesburg.

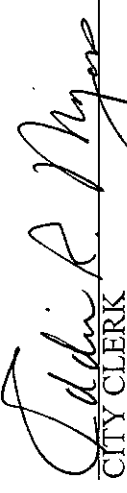

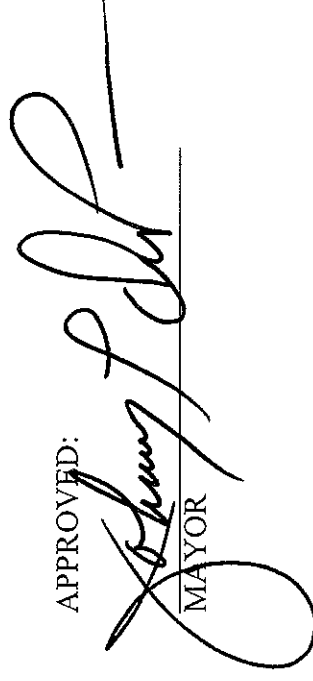

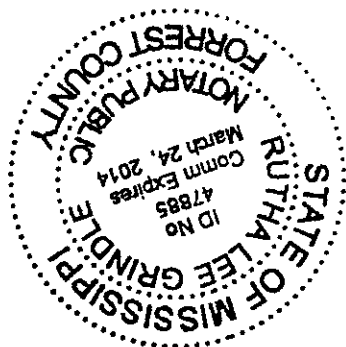
