**RESOLUTION
CONDEMNATION OF UNSAFE AND DILAPIDATED PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, on the 29th day of March, 2021, the Council of the City of Hattiesburg, Mississippi, passed a resolution announcing the intention of the City Council to hold a hearing on the 6th day of April, 2021, in the Jackie Dole Sherrill Community Center in Hattiesburg, Mississippi, as provided by Section 21-19-11 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as annotated and amended, to determine whether or not the following described property is in such a state of uncleanness as to be a menace to the health and safety of the community, to-wit:

WHEREAS, at said hearing it was determined that the aforementioned property is in such a state of uncleanness as to be a menace to the health and safety of the community and should be condemned.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hattiesburg, Mississippi, as follows:

1. A period of fifteen (15) days shall be extended to the property owner for removal of the violations listed:

**Abandoned and Unsafe Structure (International Property Maintenance Code 108.1.5.7),
Vacant Structure (International Property Maintenance Code 301.3), Overgrown Lot (IPMC 302.4),
ES (IPMC 401.1.1)**

2. If the property owners do not take corrective action within fifteen (15) days to remove the violations, then after a complete and final legal review of the property conducted by the City Attorney, the City will take action to remove all violations listed, said work to be legally contracted with a private contractor or City crews, and the cost of same plus penalty to be certified to the City Clerk for further legal Disposition.

3. A copy of this Resolution will be certified and recorded in the Chancery Clerk's Office of Forrest County, Mississippi.

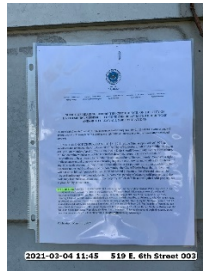

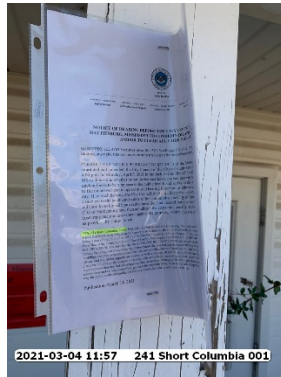

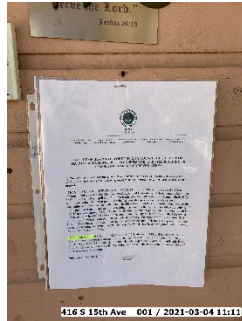

Case History: The owner of the property located at 416 S 15th Avenue, in Hattiesburg, MS was issued a Notice and a Citation of Violations listed. Then the notice was issued there was no power or water accounts active for this address and vagrants were occupying the storage shed in the rear of the property and utilizing them as the restroom facilities. The property owner did not correct these violations and did not show up for his court appearance. The judge found the owner guilty in absentia. Resolution 2020-200 was approved to clean the property from garbage and rubbish and remove the accessory structures. There has also been calls of a fire pit to stay warm inside the structure. The property has continued to be a menace to the community after initial action from the City Council. HPD has been called to this address 30+ times in 2 years and HFD 15+ times in 3 years. Code Enforcement has received countless calls from citizens and is seeking a Council Resolution to correct all violations at this address.
