BE IT REMEMBERED that the Hattiesburg City Council held a **public hearing at 4:00 p.m. Monday, June 8, 2021**, in the Jackie Dole Community Center Auditorium, same being a recessed meeting of the City Council held on May 28, 2021. The Council met for the purpose of the appeal filed by Carol Short change the roof material to metal at 309 S. 19th Ave. The HHCC Denied on April 14, 2021.

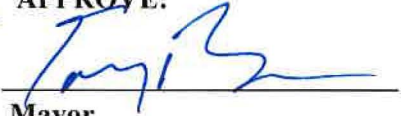
